New Requirements for PCV & LGV driving licences slip under the radar

Stricter rules for self-monitoring diabetes by holders of PCV and LGV driving licences have come into force.

The change has not been publicised by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) Up to now, the rules have stated that a professional driver on the sulphonylurea or glinide group of tablets must check their blood glucose levels with a finger prick test at least twice a day and at times relevant to driving.
